Start thinking about and observing in program areas you want to help teach. Learn about looking at camp from a staff perspective.


### TRIP BEGINS!

The LITs, with Camp Cobbossee's CITs, will travel to the American Southwest for adventure, cultural education, community service and leadership development. The trip will be supervised by our LIT director Steph Callen, and Cobbossee's CIT director.

### **MAP IT OUT**

#### TAOS, NEW MEXICO

Upon arrival, drive in our private shuttle to our first destination, Taos New Mexico. Prepare for volunteering and traveling in this unique part of the country along with with more LIT training. The first full day of the trip will be spent white water rafting down class III and IV rapids on the Rio Grande!

Visit Albuquerque , New Mexico's largest city. After arriving, head to the famous Sandia Tram for an unforgettable view of the surrounding area.
